A Successful 2024 ResiliEnhance Platform Meeting

The ResiliEnhance Platform convened a successful in-person meeting in Udine, Italy, from November 26 to 27, 2024. Led by the UNESCO Chair on Intersectoral Safety for Disaster Risk Reduction and Resilience at the University of Udine (Italy), and co-organized and hosted by the International Centre for Mechanical Sciences (CISM), the meeting brought together dedicated researchers from various universities and research centers.

The two-day event focused on collaborative learning and future action. The first day comprised a series of presentations delving into past experiences, enriching participants with valuable insights. This knowledge foundation paved the way for a dynamic working group exercise on the second day.

Through active discussions, the group unpacked key takeaways from the presentations and charted a course forward. These discussions culminated in the creation of the 2024 ResiliEnhance Chart, a significant document that acknowledges the Platform's collaborative efforts since its 2022 launch.

Closing remarks from esteemed authorities, including the Central European Initiative (CEI), the Friuli Venezia Giulia Region, and the University of Udine, further solidified the event's success.



As a next step, a report detailing the outcomes of the meeting is being prepared, and the Scientific Committee is actively working on the development of a special issue for the International Journal of Disaster Risk Reduction. Further information will be shared shortly!

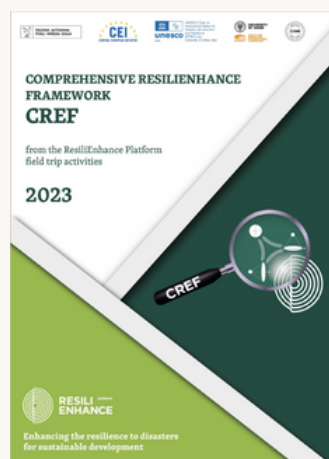
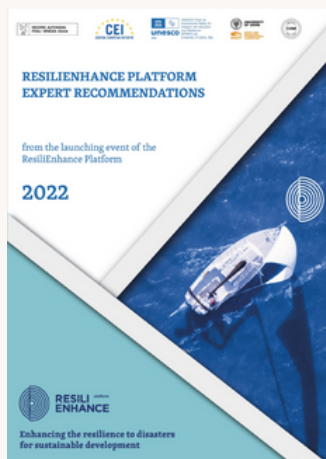
