Launch Event 2022

The launch event of the ResiliEnhance Platform took place in Udine on October 24-25, 2022, in the form of a networking and knowledge-sharing gathering, hosted by the International Centre for Mechanical Sciences (CISM).

The primary objective of the event was to harness the expertise of participants to explore territorial resilience amid complexity and adversity. Our overarching mission was the establishment of a regional platform in the CEI area devoted to strengthening resilience, thereby contributing to the 2030 Global Agenda.

Upon the conclusion of the launch event of the ResiliEnhance platform, experts collaborated to craft the Udine Chart.

Field Trip FVG 2023

From November 6 to 7, the first field trip of the ResiliEnhance Platform in the Friuli area focused on the case study of the reconstruction after the 1976 earthquake. Experts analyzed past disaster governance cases using a retrospective post-event evidence-based approach, to develop a comprehensive framework for enhancing resilience to disasters for sustainable development: the CREF.

The field trip report is being finalised and will be shared shortly with all.

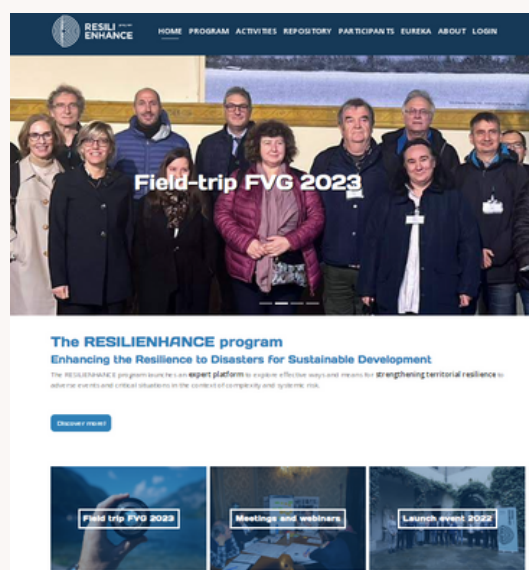
Special Issue on DRR & Resilience
